Lars Is In Charge

Despite this being his first season of professional baseball, 1B Lars Anderson has established himself as the team's offensive leader...Anderson currently leads the Drive in average (.375), RBI (4), on-base percentage (.429), slugging percentage (.563), and OPS (.991)...Lars is also tied for the team lead in home runs (1)...He is currently in the midst of a five game hitting streak in which he is batting .471 (8-for-17) with a home run, two RBI, and two runs scored...Anderson was selected in the 18th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...*Baseball America* rates him as the fifth best prospect in the Red Sox organization and the best power hitter in the organization's farm system

Finding His Place

OF Jason Place's single in the 8th inning of yesterday's game was his first hit at home since his first at bat on April 9th, spanning 13 at bats...The former Wren High School standout in front of the hometown crowd, batting .154 (2-for-13) with five strikeouts...Place was the Red Sox first selection (27th overall) in the first round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft

2007 Season: Jordan Craft will be making his second start of the 2007 season. He was the Drive's Opening Day starter at West End Field on April 9th versus the Columbus Catfish. Craft earned a no-decision after allowing four runs on three hits and four walks, while striking out three in 3.0 innings of work.

2006 Season: During his first professional season in 2006, Craft went 1-0 with a 1.72 ERA in nine games, two as a starter. He split time between the Gulf Coast League Red Sox and the the Lowell Spinners. He spent a majority of the season on the disabled list - first time after fracturing his left tibia on June 27th, and the second tim on August 19 with a left hamstring strain. Craft never surrendered more than one earned run in any of his nine outings during the 2006 season.

Last Start: Craft lasted 3.0 innings, allowing four runs, all earned, on three hits and four walks, while striking out three on April 9th versus Columbus.

At Home: Jordan Craft's only start of the season came at home on April 9th.

Miscellaneous: Jordan Craft was the Red Sox 17th pick (13th round, 403rd overall) in the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...He attended Dallas Baptist University

TOMORROW'S STARTING PITCHER

31 - Jon Lester, LHP

2007 Season: This will be the third of four rehab assignment starts for Jon Lester as he is recovering from a treatable form of anaplastic large cell lymphoma. On the season, the southpaw is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 8.0 innings pitched. His two starts have been pretty much identical as his line on April 5th was 4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, and 5 K and his line on April 10th was 4.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, and 5 K. The Red Sox have been very careful with Lester's recovery, as his first two starts he was on a 65 pitch or 4.0 inning (whichever came first) restriction. In his 3rd start those numbers have been raised to 85 pitches or 5.0 innings.

2006 Season: Lester was 7-2 with a 4.67 ERA in 15 starts for the Boston Red Sox before being placed on the DL in late August. His 7 wins ranked fourth among A.L. rookies and he became the first Red Sox rookie to win 7 games since Ken Ryan and Aaron Sele accomplished the feat in 1993. Lester was pronounced cancer-free in December.

Last Start: Lester started at home on April 10th, tossing 4.0 shutout innings versus the Columbus Catfish, surrendering two hits and walk, while striking out five.

At Home: Lester's only start at West End Field came on April 10th versus the Columbus Catfish.

On The Road: Lester's only start of the season came on April 5th in Charleston. He pitched 5.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits and a walk, while striking out five. He threw 54 pitches in the outing.

Miscellaneous: Jon Lester was selected in the second round by the Boston Red Sox in the 2002 First-Year Player Draft...He was a 3-time All-Area selection from Bellarmine Preparatory School in Tacoma, WA...Named the Gatorade State Player of the Year for Washington in 2000
