First baseman Lars Anderson, an 18th round selection in the 2006 First-Year Player Draft is embarking on his first season in professional baseball...After his first series, he is batting .267 and leads the Drive in hits (4) and RBI (2)...In his final year at Jesuit (CA) High School, the 19-year-old batted .423 (33-for-78) with 14 homers, 33 RBI, 39 runs scored and a .574 on-base percentage in 29 games...*Baseball America* rates Anderson as the best power hitter in the Red Sox farm system, and as the no. 5 overall prospect in the organization

Rookie manager Gabe Kapler is in search of his first win as a manager...Kapler retired from baseball on December 12th and was named the Drive's new manager that very same day...He spent 9 seasons in the major leagues with the Detroit Tigers, Texas Rangers, Colorado Rockies, and Boston Red Sox...He was a member of the 2004 Boston Red Sox that won the World Series

Outfielder Jason Place will make his home debut tonight for the Drive...In the four game series in Charleston, Place batted .133 (2-for-15)...The former Wren High School standout was selected 27th overall by the Red Sox in the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...During his tenure at Wren, the 18-year-old batted .463 (165-for-356) with 36 home runs, 124 RBI, 174 runs scored and 90 stolen bases in 136 games...Place was named the 2006 Gatorade High School Player of the Year

2007 Season: Tonight's start will be Craft's first start of the 2007 season. During his first professional season in 2006, Craft went 1-0 with a 1.72 ERA in nine games, two as a starter. He split time between the Gulf Coast League Red Sox and the the Lowell Spinners. He spent a majority of the season on the disabled list - first time after fracturing his left tibia on June 27th, and the second tim on August 19 with a left hamstring strain. Craft never surrendered more than one earned run in any of his nine outings during the 2006 season.

31 - Jon Lester, LHP

2007 Season: This will be the second of four rehab assignment starts for Jon Lester as he is recovering from a treatable form of anaplastic large cell lymphoma. During the 2006 season, Lester was 7-2 with a 4.67 ERA in 15 starts for the Boston Red Sox before being placed on the DL in late August. His 7 wins ranked fourth among A.L. rookies and he became the first Red Sox rookie to win 7 games since Ken Ryan and Aaron Sele accomplished the feat in 1993. Lester was pronounced cancer-free in December.

Last Start: Lester was the Opening Day starter in Charleston on April 5th versus the RiverDogs. It was the southpaw's first ever Opening Day start, at any level. He tossed 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and a walk while striking out five. The 23-year-old left-hander was consistently clocked in the mid-90s and topped out at 96 MPH. It was Lester's first appearance in a real-game situation since August 23rd.

At Home: This will be Lester's first start at home during the 2007 season.

On The Road: Lester's only start of the season came on April 5th in Charleston. He pitched 5.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits and a walk, while striking out five. He threw 54 pitches in the outing.

Miscellaneous: Jon Lester was selected in the second round by the Boston Red Sox in the 2002 First-Year Player Draft...He was a 3-time All-Area selection from Bellarmine Preparatory School in Tacoma, WA...Named the Gatorade State Player of the Year for Washington in 2000
