TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

20 - Jordan Craft, RHP

2007 Season: Jordan Craft will be making his sixth start of the season for the Drive. On the year he is 0-1 with an 11.57 ERA, 12 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11.2 innings pitched. He was the Drive's starter for the home opener on April 9th, in which he earned a no-decision.

2006 Season: During his first professional season, Craft went 1-0 with a 1.72 ERA in nine games, two as a starter. He split time between the Gulf Coast League Red Sox and the the Lowell Spinners. He spent a majority of the season on the disabled list - first time after fracturing his left tibia on June 27th, and the second time on August 19 with a left hamstring strain. Craft never surrendered more than one earned run in any of his nine outings during the 2006 season.

Last Start: Craft lasted only 0.2 innings on April 30th in Asheville versus the Tourists in which he earned a no-decision. The right-hander surrendered four runs on three hits and one walk, while striking out two. His 0.2 innings were a season-low.

At Home: In two starts at home, Craft is 0-0 with a 13.50 ERA. In four innings he has allowed six runs on six hits and four walks, while striking out four. His second start of the season on April 14th was cut short after one inning due to the game being suspended because of inclement weather. Opposing batters are hitting .333 (6-for-18) off Craft at West End Field, with one home run.

On The Road: Craft's is 0-0 with a 10.80 ERA in two starts away from home. He has allowed six earned runs on six hits and five walks while striking out three in his five innings pitched.

Miscellaneous: Jordan Craft was the Red Sox 17th pick (13th round, 403rd overall) in the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...He attended Dallas Baptist University



SUNDAY'S STARTING PITCHER

36 - Travis Beazley, RHP

2007 Season: Travis Beazley will be making his fourth start of the season for the Drive. On the year, he is 3-2 with a 4.60 ERA, 31 strikeouts and 1 walk in a team-high 29.1 innings pitched. He picked up three straight wins in three straight appearances from April 10th to April 20th while he only started one of those games.

2006 Season: During his first professional season, Beazley went 3-2 with a 2.39 ERA in 14 games, 13 as a starter with the Lowell Spinners. He struck out 59 batters while walking 19 in 67.2 innings pitched. His ERA finished as the eighth best in the New York-Penn League and he was fourth in home runs allowed with 6.

Last Start: Beazley lasted 5.0 innings on May 1st in Asheville versus the Tourists in which he surrendered the loss. The right-hander gave up four earned runs on eight hits, one a home run, while striking out seven.

At Home: In two games at home, Beazley is 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA. His first appearance was in relief on April 10th against Columbus as he went 5.0 strong innings allowing five hits and striking out four while earning the victory. In his first start of the season, Beazley picked up the win against Rome while striking out nine.

On the Road: Beazley has been roughed up away from home as he is 1-2 with a 5.79 ERA in three appearances. In his first road appearance he earned a no-decision against Charleston while pitching five perfect innings and striking out four.

Miscellaneous: Beazley was a 38th round selection by the Red Sox in the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...He attended Randolph-Macon College
